Bowel prep for colonoscopy The afternoon or evening before the colonoscopy, drink a liquid that will trigger bowel-clearing diarrhea. The exact colonoscopy prep instructions depend on the bowel prep your doctor prefers, the time of your colonoscopy, and any prior experience you've had with colon preps (if one didn't work before, you'll likely be prescribed a different one).

Preparation: Two days before your colonoscopy • Drink plenty of fluids, aim for two litres (about eight to ten glasses) per day. Please see guide on the next page. • Start restricted eating having small meals from the guide as this will help the bowel preparation medicine work properly. • Do not eat foods containing fibre.

Continued Step 4: The Purge. The night before your colonoscopy you'll take strong laxatives to clear your digestive tract. The method recommended for most people is called split dosing.

You will need to do a bowel preparation to empty your colon before your procedure. It's very important that your colon is empty for your colonoscopy. If there's stool (poop) inside your colon, your doctor may not be able to see polyps or other problems inside your colon and you may have to repeat the procedure.

It's All About the Prep: Improving Colonoscopy Bowel ...

Bowel movements usually occur within 3 hours of starting prep, but may take longer. It is recommended to stay near a restroom at this point. If bowel movements have not started within three (3) hours of starting prep, then an over-the-counter suppository (Dulcolax) is advised. Bowel movements should be watery.

4:00 pm Mix the bowel prep powder with both bottles of sports re-hydration drink. Before mixing, pour bowel prep powder in an empty pitcher or container and add re-hydration drink. Chill if desired. 5:00 pm Start to drink the Miralax. Drink (1) 8oz. glass every 15 minutes over a two hour period. Drink each glass
