The main difference between macrophages and dendritic cells is that macrophages contribute to the initiation of the inflammatory response whereas dendritic cells activate with an inflammatory response to become antigen-presenting cells. Furthermore, macrophages do not die following the activation while dendritic cells die after achieving their effector function.

MC38 cells were incubated with EdU (10 $\mu$ M) overnight in complete DMEM culture medium. 2x10<sup>6</sup> bone marrow-derived dendritic cells or macrophage were plated in a 6-well ultra-low-adherent plate (Corning) and cultured with 2  $\times$  10<sup>6</sup> EdU labeled cancer cells (MC38) in 2% FBS RPMI medium.

Abstract Bone marrow derived dendritic cells (BMDCs) are routinely employed in cell based assays to evaluate immunomodulatory and anti-inflammatory activities. Hence, simplified, stepwise, defined and standardized methods are required for isolation of bone marrow cells from mice, propagating them in presence of growth factors and obtaining high and reproducible yields of BMDCs.

### **A stepwise procedure for isolation of murine bone marrow ...**

In vitro cultures of bone marrow-derived macrophages and dendritic cells are well-established and valuable methods for immunological studies. Here, a method for culturing and identifying both DCs and macrophages from a single culture of primary mouse bone marrow cells using the cytokine granulocyte macrophage colony-stimulating factor (GM-CSF) is described.
