### Selecting a project in Solution Explorer doesn't ...

To open the window select View > Solution Explorer. Solution Explorer displays the projects that form your solution, the files and folders in a project as they appear on the physical hard drive, and any assemblies, COM objects or files the project references.

### Solution Explorer - Micro Focus

In the left pane, expand Other Project Types, then select Visual Studio Solutions. In the center pane, select the Blank Solution template. Name your solution QuickSolution, then select the OK button. The Start Page closes, and a solution appears in Solution Explorer on the right-hand side of the Visual

### Introduction to projects and solutions - Visual Studio ...

To look at the contents of newer, sdk-style project files in Visual Studio, right-click on the project node in Solution Explorer and select Edit <projectname>. To look at the contents of .NET Framework and other projects of that style, first unload the project (right-click on the project node in Solution Explorer and select Unload Project ).

### Learn about solutions and projects - Visual Studio ...

In Visual Studio's menu go to Tools > Options > Projects and Solutions. Then check "Track Active Item in Solution Explorer". Add a Keyboard Shortcut to Change the Track Active Item in Solution Explorer Setting This is great but sometimes this isn't ideal if you're temporarily opening up lots of files to look through them.

### How to Show the Current Active File in Visual Studio ...

Navigate To Tools -> Options -> Projects and Solutions -> General -> " Track Active Item in Solution Explorer" and check the option to turn on this feature automatically. With this option enabled, when you open any code file in Visual Studio that you are editing the same file would get automatically highlighted inside of the solution Explorer.

### Keep Track of your active files inside Solution Explorer ...

How Do I Code Sign on Visual Studio? It's really not too difficult. Assuming you've already bought the certificate and installed it, all you need to do is: Click the project in the Solution Explorer, then select Properties. On the signing tab, toggle on the Sign the ClickOnce Manifests checkbox. Click Select from Store

Complete the following steps to add an assembly reference in Microsoft Visual Studio. Select the project in the Solution Explorer. Select Project»Add Reference to launch the Add Reference dialog box. ### Select a file/node/item in Solution Explorer ...

If you are like me, you despise the automatic "Preview" feature that comes enabled by default in Visual Studio 2013. It seems like a good idea: select a file in the Solution Explorer and it is automatically opened in a special preview tab. Unless it is already open in a tab, in which case that tab is selected.

### How to Disable Previewing the Solution Explorer's Selected ...

Diff files from the Solution Explorer. Select two files in solution explorer; Right-click; Select "Diff selected files" See those files open in a diff window; simple.

### Solution File Diff - Visual Studio Marketplace

Extension for Visual Studio - Control click any two files in Solution explorer and then right click and select "Compare Files..." and the configured third-party comparison tool will come up show a diff between the two files.

So if you do this, you need to hit the key TWICE - once to select the current item, once to turn the setting back off. If I find a better solution to the problem I'll update this post. When I'm working in Visual Studio, I generally turn off the option to automatically track the current item in the Solution Explorer.

### Select Current Item in Visual Studio Solution Explorer

We have discussed this features over here - "Preview Tab in Visual Studio" . Do you know, you can quickly enable or disable this features just directly from solution explorer? In the solution explorer, you can select or deselect the "Preview Selected Items" options, to enable this features.

### Preview Selected Items in Visual Studio - Daily .NET Tips

That's great but I prefer a clean slate when I open solutions - no files open and all the tree nodes collapsed in Solution Explorer. I wrote the Clean Solution extension to provide this behavior in previous version of Visual Studio. This feature is now native to Visual Studio 2019 and can be enabled with two separate checkboxes.
